## 1. THE LABYRINTH OF TIME

---

Described by the press as monumental, *The Labyrinth of Time* (LDT) is a polyartistic and technological work of a new kind.

A labyrinth of sensations conceived as a whole — from virtual worlds (VR) to polyartistic practices (dance, theatre, music) and spectacular monumental projections — the LDT is a memorial journey to the edges of uninhabited worlds.

Creation, research and transmission are the three inseparable actions-reactions at the heart of the invention process of the *Labyrinth*.

Its *work in progress* development combines phases of research and development (R&D), including scientific world premieres and the creation of unique technological tools.

## 2. A WORK ADAPTEDE TO YOUR MEANS

---

From a simple video projection — small form — to the installation of a large form of the *Labyrinth*, tout projet de création du LDT est unique et réalisé sur mesure, en fonction d'un événement particulier, d'un lieu et des moyens à disposition.

## 3. AESTHETIC STAKES

---

A polymorphic writing of memory, which crosses, uncrosses and interweaves at different scales of time and space, the LDT consists of satellites (autonomous works) and large cycles (real-time algorithmic invention and interaction).

The pairing of chance and determinism is at the heart of the invention of the *Labyrinth*, evoking a simultaneous feeling of presence and absence.

*“Imagine what I cannot imagine,  
in the questioning the link, causal relationships and the role of chance,  
getting lost in multisensory spaces, hidden and entangled memory fibres”.*

### Technical section

The technical installation of *the Labyrinth of Time* can be handled in two ways:

1. Entirely "turnkey" (rental via 3icar),
2. Partially (computers, sound card, software, for example), to complement a sound and video installation provided by the host institution.

#### Indicative examples:

- Simple outdoor audio equipment rental: from 1,000 €
- High-power projector rental for monumental outdoor mapping: from €3,000

## 6. STEPS TO COMMISSION A LABYRINTH OF TIME

---

**Initial contact and pre-project for commissioning the *Labyrinth***, information to send to M. de Gérando ([sdegerando@gmail.com](mailto:sdegerando@gmail.com)).

Information to specify:

- *Name and address of the commissioner, with phone and email*
- *Date and duration of the planned event*
- *Creation venues (precise descriptions with photos)*
- *Choice of modules or the entirety of a Labyrinth*
  1. *Monumental projections and mapping,*
  2. *Real-time algorithmic creations,*
  3. *Digital arts — different types of virtual paintings on fixed media or generated in real time (TV screen),*
  4. *Electroacoustic sound installations,*
  5. *Concerts,*
  6. *Virtual reality (VR headset),*
  7. *Video installations,*
  8. *Sculptures,*
  9. *Polyartistic performances polyartistiques(dance, theatre, music and technology),*
  10. *Educational workshops,*
  11. *Publications et vente - catalogues d'exposition, ouvrages d'art consacré au LDT et articles de recherche.*
- *Research collaboration*
- *Material requirements (on-site equipment and rental)*
- *Budget*
- *Potential partners*

Following this, M. de Gérando will write, always in liaison with the partner(s), a precise “**Specifications Document**” for the creation of your *Labyrinth* and then, if requested, a “**Co-production Estimate**” (3icar — research and creation association)

The commissioner places a “**Commission Contract**” with the composer (standard form provided by SdG). Once the contract is signed, S. de Gérando begins the composition and programming of the work (allow sufficient time between the signing date and the production date of the work)

## ANNEXS

### 1. BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE — STÉPHANE DE GÉRANDO

---

Stéphane de Gérando (L'Haÿ-les-Roses, France, 23 June 1965) is a contemporary French creator and researcher. He has dual training as a composer and researcher, at the Conservatoire National Supérieur de Musique et de Danse de Paris (Premier Prix and 3rd cycle in composition), at university (doctorate, habilitation to supervise research) and at IRCAM (music computing curriculum).

He won the international Stipendianspreis 1994 at the Darmstadt Contemporary Music Festival, the Prize of the Association of Former Students and Students of the Conservatoires Nationaux Supérieurs de Musique et d'Art Dramatique de Paris (1991), the Academic Prize of SACEM (1995), and was a laureate of the Sasakawa Foundation in 1993 and 1994. His catalogue includes more than 130 works, from solo instrument to orchestra, with or without electronics, digital installations, monumental projections, virtual paintings, polyartistiquescreations — theatre, dance, music, digital technologies.

Since 2007, he has devoted himself primarily to the *Labyrinth of Time*. His publications (books, articles, dictionary) address historical, aesthetic, pedagogical and institutional questions related to creation, as well as algorithmic issues (world premieres) or those related to digital technologies, in collaboration with researchers such as Athanase Papadopoulos, Franck Jedrzejewski, Christophe Mourougane (mathematicians), Jérôme Pétri (astrophysicist), Louis Bigo (computer scientist) and Gilles Baroin (doctor-engineer) for the latest version of a satellite of the Labyrinth in virtual reality (VR headset).
